Nearly every business has some hazardous materials risk. This risk may be due to the use or storage of such materials on site. For others, the risk may be due to proximity to an industry or transportation facility. For example, the 1996 Weyauwega train derailment required the evacuation of the entire city for 16 days.

DRCV's 2019 seminars are exploring such hazardous materials risks for the different aspects of the emergency management cycle—our Spring Seminar in May focused on mitigation and preparedness, while our Fall Seminar on November 14th will explore response and recovery.
