Nearly every business has some hazardous materials risk. This risk may be due to the use or storage of such materials on site. For others, the risk may be due to proximity to an industry or transportation facility. For example, the 1996 Weyauwega train derailment required the evacuation of the entire city for 16 days.

DRCV's 2019 seminars will explore such hazardous materials risks for the different aspects of the emergency management cycle—our Spring Seminar on May 8<sup>th</sup> will focus on mitigation and preparedness with our Fall Seminar in November focusing on Response and Recovery.

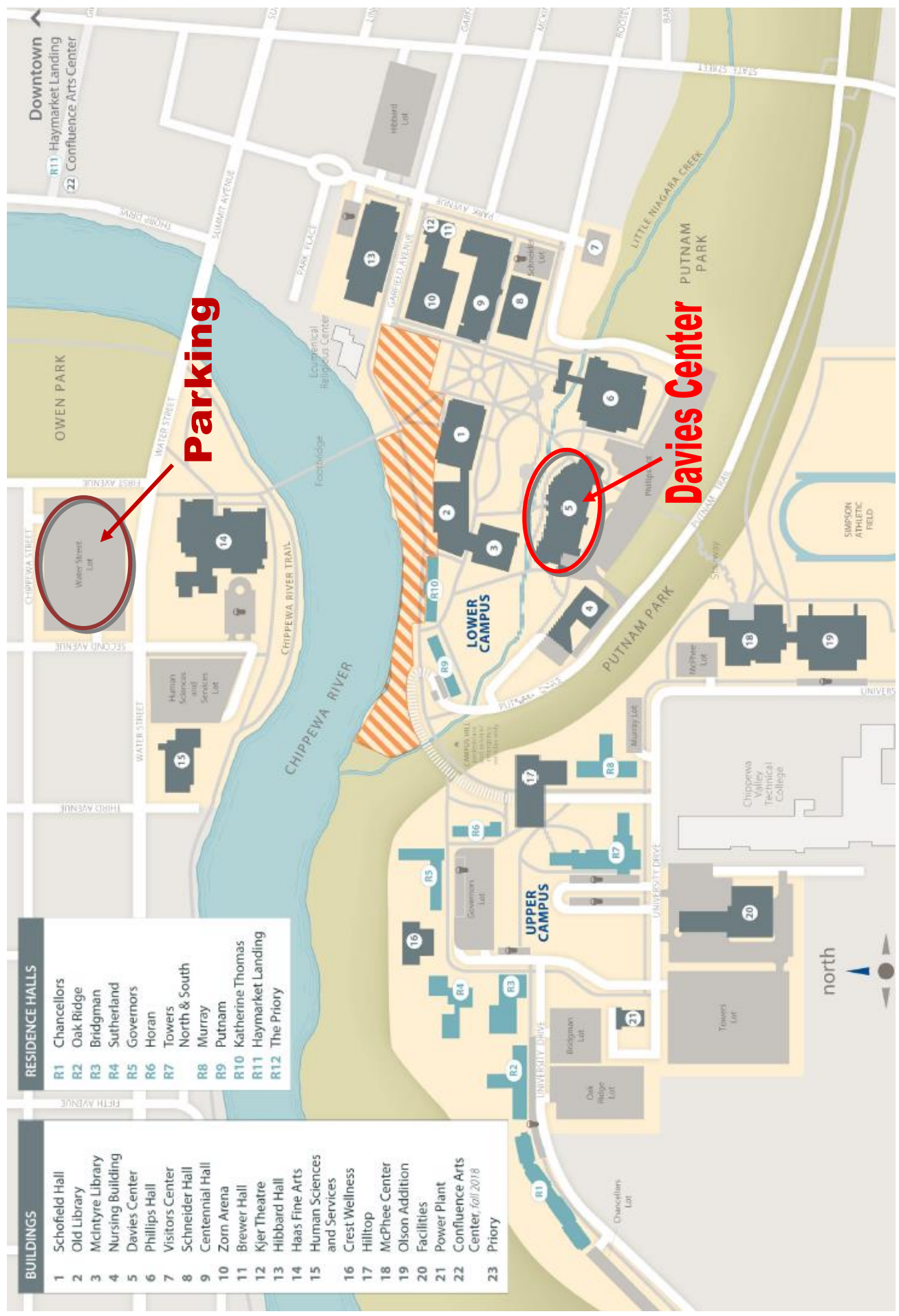
