PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

The ATLS® program was developed by the American College of Surgeons, and is a two-day course designed to teach physicians a systematic approach to assessment and treatment of the trauma patient. ATLS® provides the participant with a safe, reliable method for immediate management of the injured patient.

COURSE OBJECTIVES

The ATLS® program provides participants with a safe, reliable method for immediate management of the injured patient and basic knowledge necessary to:

- Assess the patient's condition rapidly and accurately.
- Resuscitate and stabilize the patient according to priority.
- Determine if the patient's needs exceed a facility's capabilities.
- Arrange appropriately for the patient's definitive care.
- Ensure that optimum care is provided.

COURSE TOPICS

The ATLS® course content is presented through a combination of interactive discussions and application of learned skills during unfolding scenarios.

- Airway and Ventilatory Management
- Shock
